Men used to land Work back
from the Trenches but I think

it is only a tale they have not been
round and doted any of us if they
did they would only send young Bhab
not Men over 21 if I had been
in England I might have stood a
Chance but I think it is much use
none Well Dear I had a letter from
Arthur yesterday he said he
has got to come out here as a ³ Journeyman
Platelayer he is going to get a
Shilling an hour and work not less
than 52 hours a week and wear
private Clothes the Army finds him
food and Lodging so he want have
a bad job how does the Gen. look
now I should get a sitting at White
ley home this year if I was again
now I must close My Letter with
the best of Love from your
